THAILAND'S KEY PROGRESS ON COMBATING TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS

January 2015 - March 2016



The Phuket Provincial Court dismissed charges of defamation and libel against 2 journalists for reporting the incident of official complicity. The Australia – Asia Program to Combat Trafficking in Persons (AAPTIP) and the Courts of Justice co-hosted the workshop to enhance cooperation in the criminal justice sector on human trafficking. The Royal Thai Police and U.S. Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) have started their cooperation to target registered sex offenders whom the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) believe are likely to engage in child sex tourism by taking referrals from the Operation Angel Watch. The new Department of Anti-Human Trafficking was set up within the Office of Attorney General.

Thailand hosted 1st bilateral meeting between the Lao Anti-Trafficking Division and the Royal Thai Police and the Department of Special Investigation. NVADER and the Family Connection Foundation provided information to the Ministry of Interior which led to the rescue of 8 Lao girls and arrest of a manager of a karaoke bar in NakhonPhanom on child exploitation and forced labour charges.

The cabinet approved in principle the draft Royal Ordinance on the Bringing of Migrant Workers to Work in Thailand.

The Ministry of Labour submitted to the cabinet amendments to the Labour Protection Act 2008.
